Summary

Get Set Learn is a literacy program for parents and pre-school children, birth to 4 years. Outcomes for the program include parent skill-building to help children prepare for school. Parents helping their children practice and build literacy skills gives them confidence and improved parenting skills while boosting confidence in kids.

We offered 4 sessions of **Get Set Learn** this year. A total of 66 families and 85 children attended the program.

Thanks to the funding provided by the Lyle S. Hallman Foundation, we were able to offer the program to all families. Our previous funding restricted us to invite families receiving social assistance only.

We conducted evaluation surveys to learn about the parents' feedback at the beginning and end of the program. The following report documents the results of the surveys, what we learned, and our achievements.

Findings from the surveys indicate a positive impact on families attending the **Get Set Learn** program.

<u>Overview</u>

The evaluation surveys from last year indicated that families were finding the Get Set Learn program tremendously helpful during the pandemic. The program provided a platform for parents to connect while engaging their children in literacy-based activities. Based on this feedback, we decided to run the program more often.

Previously we were offering it to families receiving social assistance. Funding from Lyall S. Hallman allowed us to reach out to more families with a program open to all. It was particularly helpful for families experiencing isolation due to the pandemic.

Get Set Learn Program Outcomes:

Get Set Learn gives parents knowledge, skills, and opportunity to:

- See themselves as their children's first and most important teachers.
- Engage in family literacy activities (talk, read, sing, draw and play with shapes and numbers) to help their children to be successful at school.
- Learn positive discipline practices so that family literacy activities are more successful.
- Connect with other parents, know they are not alone.
- Seek the help they need for themselves and their children.
- Develop community connections to progress with their goals.
- Learn and develop employment skills.

Get Set Learn 2021 Survey Results

Get Set Learn program served a total of 66 families in the year 2021.

We asked parents to complete an evaluation at the end of the program. Questions and raw data are below.
